

Cunnamulla Outback Escape

This two-day itinerary presents a carefully curated introduction to Cunnamulla, offering visitors an immersive and well-paced outback experience. It combines relaxation, cultural storytelling, and authentic regional attractions, allowing guests to connect with the landscape, history, and community within a short yet enriching stay.

Day 1: Arrival, Artesian Relaxation and Local Stories

3:10pm – Make your way to the historic railway station.

3:10pm – 4:15pm – Attend the All Aboard Sound and Light Show, an engaging storytelling experience that brings Cunnamulla's history and characters to life through immersive visuals and narration.

4:30pm – Enjoy free time to further explore the town or return to the hot springs for additional relaxation.

6:30pm – Dine at a local venue, experiencing the welcoming atmosphere and regional cuisine.

7:45pm – Conclude the day with a campfire experience and stargazing, taking advantage of the clear outback skies and tranquil environment.

9:30pm – Overnight stay.

Day 2: Local Discovery and Outback Indulgence

8:30am – Begin the morning with a relaxed routine, enjoying the quiet pace of the outback.

9:30am – Breakfast in town, followed by check-out.

10:30am – Explore the main street, browsing local businesses, artisan products, and community spaces that reflect the character of Cunnamulla.

11:30am – Undertake the Heritage Trail walk, discovering significant historical sites and gaining a deeper understanding of the town's development and cultural identity.

12:30pm – Depart for Charlotte Plains, travelling through expansive outback landscapes.

1:00pm – Arrive at Charlotte Plains, a working sheep station offering an authentic pastoral experience.

1:30pm – Enjoy a private artesian bore bath, allowing visitors to relax in naturally heated mineral water in a peaceful station setting.

4:00pm – Depart, concluding the Cunnamulla experience.
